23-02-2023 Thursday



It is located at the beautiful hill named Kidavankunnu, New Mahe. K.E Safiya Autism centre was established in 2012 and it is managed by Dubai - Mahe welfare association. We visited there along with our teachers. We started from our college at 1.30 pm and reached there at 1.45 pm.

When we reached there, one of the staff lead us to the auditorium and we got a class from the principle of K.E Safiya autism centre named Mr. Varguse. He took detailed class about the autism. After the class of the principal we followed the staff members to visit each classes and labs by dividing into groups.
